- 3. Describe the most important school and/or community activities in which you have been involved, and honors or awards you have received within the last four years.
- 4. What do you believe you can or have contributed to the community?
- 5. What struggles you have faced to continue or return to school?
- 6. Why do you want a scholarship? How would it benefit you to receive a scholarship?

## Applicants must be a member of ANTSHE (provide your member number) and complete their application as outlined in these instructions.

The criteria used to determine eligibility for scholarship recipients are as follows:

### Graduate Students:

- 1. GPA of 3.5
  - 2. Accepted into an accredited graduate program for a minimum of 6 hours
  - 3. Completed bachelor's degree

#### Undergraduate 4 years

- 1. Enrolled in degree or certificate program at time of scholarship award for 6 credit hours
- 2. Have completed at least 30 credit hours
- 3. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 based on the last 30 credit hours

#### Undergraduate 2 years

- 1. Enrolled in a degree or certificate program at time of scholarship award for 6credit hours
- 2. Have complete at least 15 credit hours
